	INTRODUCTION	New Jerusalem Children's Home "NJCH" is Christ Consciousness Faith-based non-profit organization presently accommodating 87 children from 0 to 18 years of age. It is a small entity with a big vision. We aim to become one of the best children's homes in Africa in the provision of holistic and integrated quality care to orphaned,	

New Jerusalem Children's Home is building a 556 square meters building — boys residential unit to shelter 40 of its medically and socially challenged children and youth. The proposed building is costed at R3.8 million

abandoned, abused, traumatized, vulnerable and HIV positive children and youth

#### **NEED FOR A BOYS RESIDENTIAL UNIT**

New Jerusalem Children's Home has a total of 87 children at present (February 2016). Our girl child and youth are properly sheltered in the Green House – Container house of the home which provides a child with a simple under the bed privacy, space between a bed and the wardrobe, there are staying in fours/six in bigger rooms and twos in smaller rooms. Their setup also gives them space to put in bedroom tables/study mats to allow more study space or morning indoor exercise.

The container house also offers a child with:

- Bathrooms/showers
- Kitchen
- Dining area
- Lounge
- Dedicated study area
- Upstairs Balconies

The boys of the home on the other hand are sheltered in an overcrowded dormitory area. Even though the area provides space for a bed it does not provide a room for 85% of what girl child of the home is getting. As an organisation we feel this vast different a child bedroom setup might negatively impact both girls and boy's physiological development and dissatisfaction of a child in our care. This might develop a distance between our children and boys might see themselves as not adequately sheltered and girls might see themselves as being better than boys.



**Phina's dorm,** area where boys are currently sheltered and sleeping is the old double garage, part of our drive in the organisation is to recycle the buildings and give them a secondary use and avoid demolishing them, which was converted to address the need of time, sheltering and providing a roof over the children head.

The current boy's residential unit doesn't have any of what is mentioned in the girl child setting, it doesn't have: -

- ✓ Bathrooms children have to walk to the admin block for showers and bathroom and use a bucket during the night
- √ No study space
- √ No personal space
- ✓ Share wardrobes
- Use the outside dining area or the indoor dining area during harsh weather conditions

PROPOSED NEED

New Jerusalem Children's Home has a need to build a 556 square meters building and dedicate it to boys of the home, the building will be known as the boy's residential unit, it will accommodate the currently overcrowded boy's dormitory and the container house extension. The structure will have all what the container house have and it will have an additional room which will be known as the medical room of the home, it will provide full medical support for the children and youth of the home.
